Features of a Formal Report:

- title
- an introductory paragraph
- third person (he, she, they)
- paragraphs
- factual and technical language
- present tense
- sub-headings (e.g. appearance, habitat, diet)

Facts about Komodo Dragons:

- They are the largest species of lizards in the world. Another name for them is 'land crocodile'. On average, they live for thirty years.
- They're covered in dry, scaly skin, hatch from eggs and are coldblooded reptiles. The climate determines how hot or cold they feel.

- They live on four islands in Indonesia. These islands are hot and dry, with grasslands and savannahs.
- Their tough skin is usually brown and green, which helps them not to stand out. They have long tails, flat heads and strong legs.
- They have short legs and a long tail. They also have 60 sharp teeth in their mouth. They can often be found using their long claws to climb trees.
- Komodo dragons only eat meat. They have been known to eat deer, pigs, and water buffalo. They have even been observed eating each other.
