Homework/Extension Step 1: Nouns

Teaching Note

We recommend teaching the terminology of *noun* in Year 1 so that children understand the difference between the word types and the jobs that they have within sentences. The resources for this step will include the terminology of *noun*.

Differentiation:

Questions 1, 4 and 7 (Varied Fluency)

Developing Identify if a statement is true or false using understanding of common nouns. Using CVC and CCVC/CVCC words.

Expected Identify if a statement is true or false using understanding of common nouns. Using high frequency or phonetically decodable words.

Greater Depth Identify if a statement is true or false using understanding of common nouns. Includes some compound nouns and some words which are not easily decodable.

Questions 2, 5 and 8 (Varied Fluency)

Developing Sort the words into the table to show which are nouns and which are not. Includes common nouns using CVC and CCVC/CVCC words.

Expected Sort the words into the table to show which are nouns and which are not. Includes common nouns using high frequency or phonetically decodable words.

Greater Depth Sort the words into the table to show which are nouns and which are not. Includes some compound nouns and some words which are not easily decodable.

Questions 3, 6 and 9 (Application and Reasoning)

Developing Identify which word is the odd one out using understanding of common nouns. Using CVC and CCVC/CVCC words.

Expected Identify which word is the odd one out using understanding of common nouns. Using high frequency or phonetically decodable words.

Greater Depth Identify which word is the odd one out using understanding of common nouns. Includes some compound nouns and some words which are not easily decodable.
