Homework/Extension Using 'so', 'and', 'but' and 'or'

Developing

1. A – but, B – so, C – and
2. A and B are true. C is false because it has the wrong conjunction so it doesn't make sense. The correct conjunction is 'so'.
3. The wrong conjunction has been used to join the two clauses. The correct conjunction is 'and'.

Expected

4. A – or, B – and, C – but
5. B and C are true. A is false because it has the wrong conjunction so it doesn't make sense. The correct conjunction is 'so'.
6. The correct conjunction has been used but it isn't joining two clauses together. 'Or' should come after 'apple' in the sentence.

Greater Depth

7. A – but/so, B – so/and, C – or/but
8. A and C are true. B is false because it has the wrong conjunctions so it doesn't make sense. The correct conjunctions are 'and/but'.
9. 'But' is the wrong conjunction, it should be 'or'. The conjunction 'and' isn't joining two clauses together. It should come after 'me'.
