Expected Questions to support identifying root words, prefixes and suffixes, using the prefixes 'super-', 'anti-', 'auto-' and the suffixes '-er', '-ful', '-less', '-est' and 'ly'. Words included are taken from the Year 3 and Year 4 expectations.









Greater Depth Questions to support identifying root words, prefixes and suffixes, using the prefixes 'super-', 'anti-', 'auto-', 'dis-' and 'mis-' and the suffixes '-er', '-ful', '-less', '-est' and 'ly'. Words included are primarily from the Year 3 and Year 4 expectation but also included more uncommon words.
