

Non-chronological Report

Write a non-chronological report of a subject that interests you.

A non-chronological report is a non-fiction text that focuses on one subject.

It should include lots of facts about that subject.

It should not be written in time order.

You might want to write a non-chronological report about polar bears for example.

You might include facts about what they look like, where they live, what they eat etc.

Features often included in non-chronological reports:

- an introductory paragraph
- paragraphs with a different focus
- subheadings
- present tense
- labelled diagrams or pictures
- fun or interesting facts
- specific or technical vocabulary
- a glossary
- formal tone
