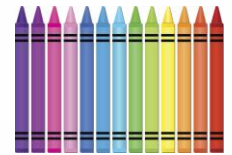

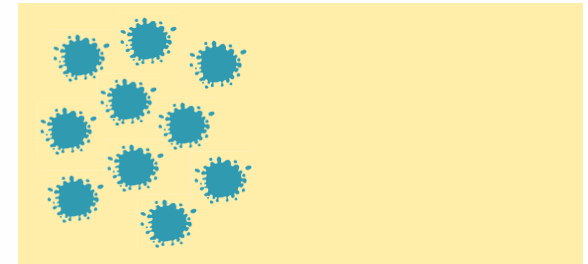

Outdoor

Provide a number track to twenty on the ground. Ask children to roll a large dice and jump that many along the track. Then roll the dice again and count on as they do more jumps.

Fine Motor

Provide beads of two different colours. Children to thread a number of one colour onto a string, then roll a dice. Using the second colour, children thread the number shown on the dice and count on.

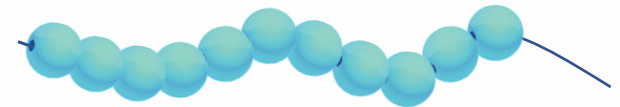
