

Year 1 Make Equal Groups – Grouping – Guidance for Parents/Carers

Activity:

The aim of this activity is for children to practise making equal groups by grouping. There are three questions to complete. The first two questions allow children to practise the skill, while the third question extends them as they have to problem solve and explain their answer.
