Provide a range of equipment and number cards to fifty. Ask children to pick a number card and represent it using various equipment.

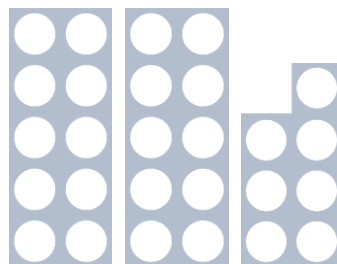
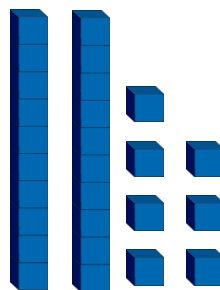
Writing

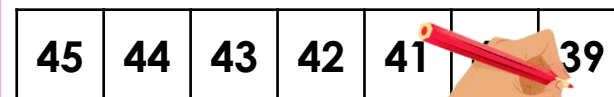

Water

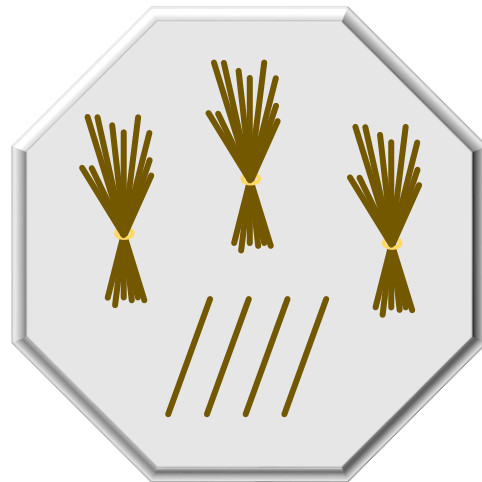
Write numbers to fifty on sea creatures. Place number names around the water tray. Ask children to find a numbered sea creature and match it with the correct number name.

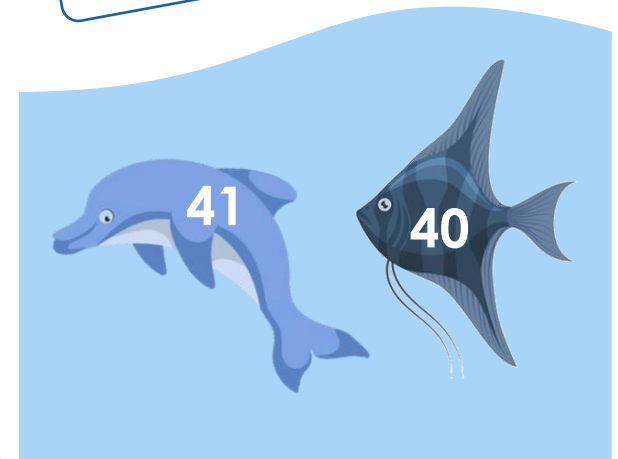

Advice and ideas

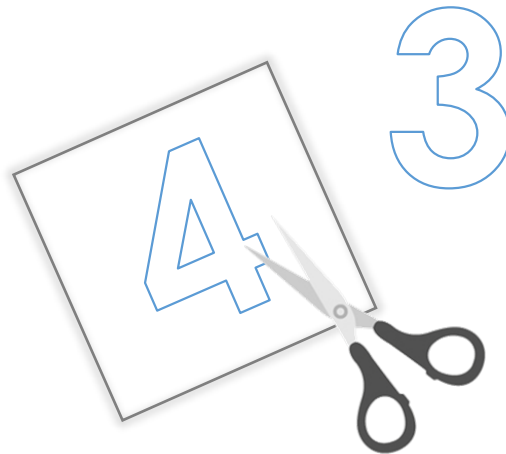
Fine Motor
