Describing Movement

1. forwards
2. rabbit – backwards; fish – forwards
3. spider
4. Tony is incorrect, the tortoise must move 3 squares forwards.
5. Various answers, for example: ladybird – 1 square forward, 2 squares right; bird – 2 squares backward, 1 square right
6. Various answers, for example: 3 squares backwards, 2 squares right; 2 squares right, 3 squares backwards
