Activity:

The aim of this activity is for children to practise finding a half. There are three questions to complete. The first two questions allow children to practise the skill, while the third question extends them as they have to problem solve and explain their answer.

1. 60 = 30; 20 = 10; 40 = 20; 70 = 35

2. A = 2; B = 3; C = 4; D = 1

3. Daisy can buy the dress because half of £20 is £10; or the jumper because half of £18 is £9. She cannot buy the jacket because half of £26 is £13 so she does not have enough money.
