Year 2 Related Facts – Guidance for Parents

Activity:

The aim of this activity is for children to practise finding related facts, using their knowledge of place value. There are three questions to complete. The first two questions allow children to practise the skill, while the third question extends them as they have to problem solve and explain their answer.

Vocabulary:

Related facts, also known as **fact families**, are a group of four calculations that are created using the same three numbers, for example 2 + 5 = 7, 5 + 2 = 7, 7 - 2 = 5, 7 - 5 = 2. They can also be used to identify related facts up to 100, for example 20 + 50 = 70.

A **calculation** is a way to determine an amount. It may involve addition, subtraction, multiplication or division.



- 3. $6 + 3 = 9 \rightarrow$ They will cost 90p. 60 + 30 is the same as 6 tens + 3 tens. 6 + 3 = 9 so 6 tens + 3 tens = 9 tens, which is 90.
