Activity:

The aim of this activity is for children to practise finding unit fractions. There are three questions to complete. The first two questions allow children to practise the skill, while the third question extends them as they have to problem solve and explain their answer.

Vocabulary:

A **representation** refers to a number that has been shown in different ways. This number may have been shown in numerals, words or using mathematical equipment such as Base 10 or a place value chart.

A unit fraction is a fraction where the numerator is 1. For example, $\frac{1}{4}$.
