

Activity:

The aim of this activity is for children to practise drawing accurately. There are three questions to complete. The first two questions allow children to practise the skill, while the third question extends them as they have to problem solve and explain their answer.

1. B
2. A – 1cm 8mm; B – a line longer than 1cm 8mm and shorter than 7cm 4mm;
C – 7cm 4mm; D – a line longer than 7cm 4mm and shorter than 9cm 2mm;
E – 9cm 2mm
3. Jack is incorrect because one of his lines is 2cm 8mm.
