

Year 3 Ice Cream with Friends Comprehension – Guidance for Parents/Carers

Worksheet:

The aim of this activity is for children to practise using their inference and comprehension skills to answer questions about a non-text guided reading. There are a number of questions to complete which focus on various aspects and topics of the comprehension. Some questions may require children to give their opinion about the image.

Vocabulary:

A **verb** is an action word such as **jump, skip, shout**.

Simple past tense is used to describe an action that has started and ended in a time before now. For example: I **walked** the dog.

Present perfect tense is used to talk about experiences that are not time specific, an action that has started in the past but has an outcome in the present, or an action that has started in the past and is continuous up until the present. It is formed by using the present tense of the verb 'have' plus a past participle, for example: I **have been** to Spain.

2. Various answers, for example: Sun hat, sun glasses, purse, watches, bags and flowers.
3. Personal response. Various answers, for example: Why are the three ladies stood up?
Ensure questions relate to image.
