

Activity:

The aim of this activity is for children to practise prepositional phrases. There are three questions to complete. The first two questions allow children to practise the skill, while the third question extends them as they have to apply their learning to get the answer.

Vocabulary:

A **preposition** is a type of word used to express time, place or cause, for example: after, under, over.


A **prepositional phrase** is a group of words which contains a preposition followed by a noun, pronoun or noun phrase but no verb. For example: under the bed.
