

Multiply by 10

1. $60 = 6 \times 10$
2. B
3. A is <; B is =; C is >
4. Various answers, for example: $5 \times 10 = 50$, $6 \times 10 = 60$, $7 \times 10 = 70$.
5. Lyra bought 7 bags. If she gives one bag away, she will have 60 eggs left, because $7 - 1 = 6$, and $6 \times 10 = 60$.
6. Kel is correct because the highest possible number on each die is 6. $6 + 6 = 12$ and $12 \times 10 = 120$. Sufjan is incorrect because it is impossible for them to make 0×10 or 1×10 , as the lowest possible total across the two dice is $1 + 1 = 2$.
