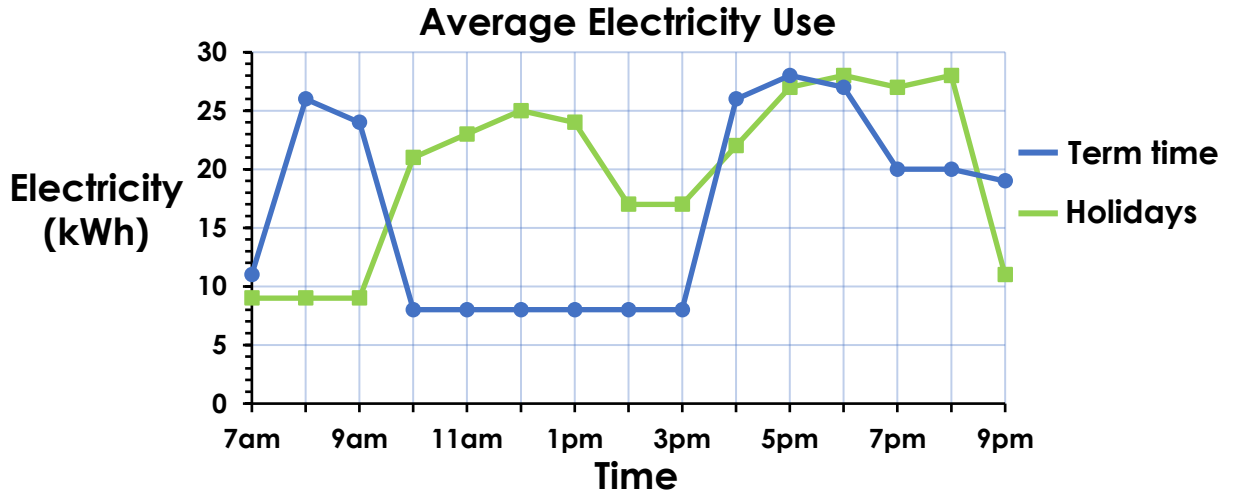


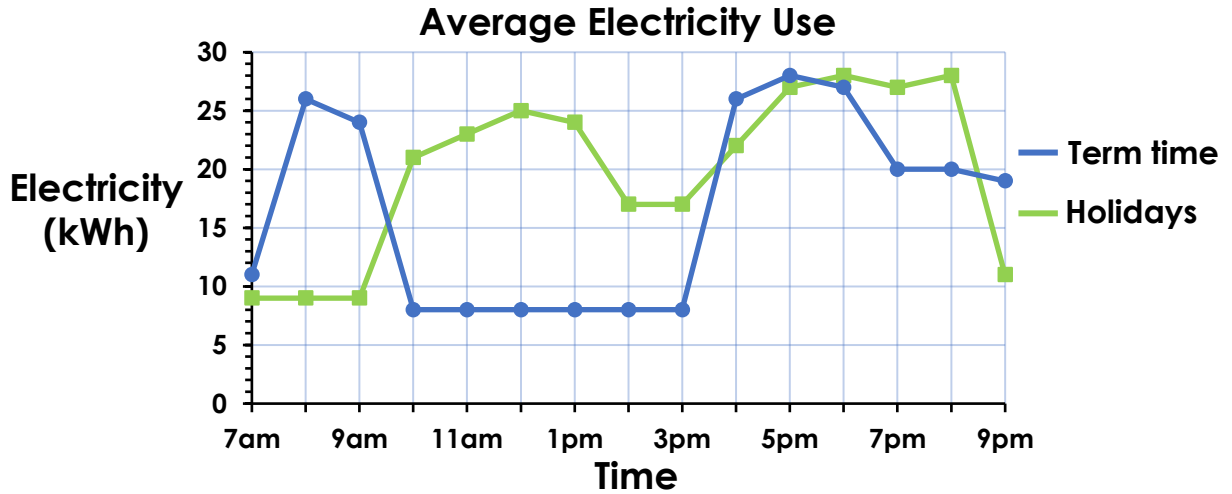
Read and Interpret Line Graphs
