

Monday – Setting Descriptions

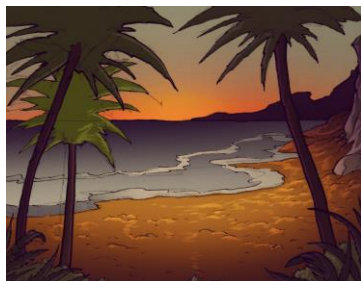
Choose a setting from the list below and write expanded noun phrases to describe it.
