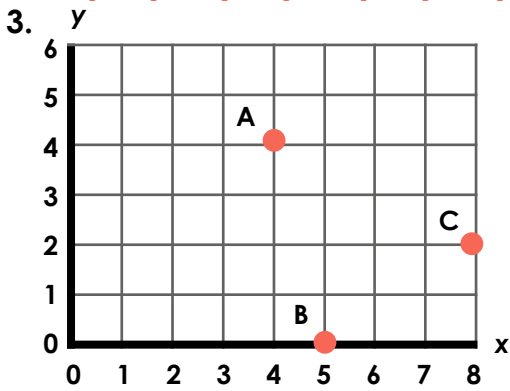


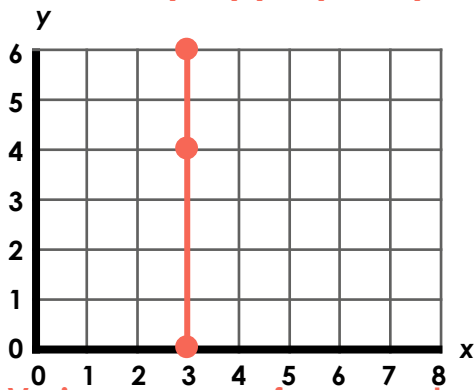
The First Quadrant

1. A. (2, 7); B. (1, 4); C. (7, 3); D. (4, 3); E. (4, 0)

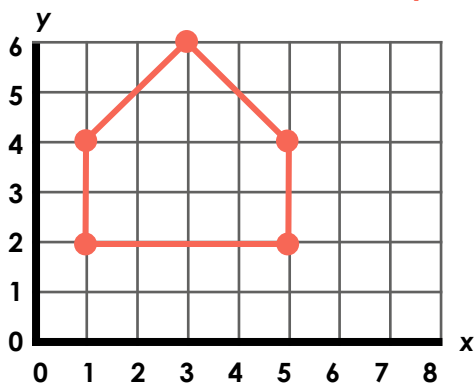
2. A. (2, 6); B. (4, 8); C. (7, 5); D. (5, 3)



4. False. When the value of x is the same in different coordinates, this will create a vertical line. This is because the coordinate will not move along the horizontal x -axis as each coordinate has the same x value. For example, where the x -axis coordinate is 3, the coordinates (3, 0) (3, 4) and (3, 6) create a vertical line as shown below.
